Hampton Safari Mk2 (hydraulic drive) "Kantara 3"

A very special/unique 1982 specimen which was built by "Cheeseman Rollo & Co" on the Thames. This is thought to be a one-off on the Norfolk Broads as it has Hydraulic Drive (oil cooled) propulsion which was usually only ever fitted to the MK1J model. The drive is run by an exceptional economical Nanni twin cylinder diesel engine. This is fitted under the afterdeck in the gas stowage vicinity, however; a clever extension was fitted to the rear to enable the 2x gas bottles also to be housed.

This 4 berth build is in fabulous condition both inside and out, having had a vast amount of money spent on it. The fit-out inside is amazing and it completely maximises the living space with unusual storage ideas in abundance, including fully fitted cupboards and draws in the galley and rear cabin. In the rear cabin above the fixed double bed are overhead lockers and the opposite side stands a fitted wardrobe area. As the engine is located at the back as described above, you get a complete full-size flowing galley of which boasts

- a full size four burner hob with oven and grill
- a full size 3-way fridge/freezer which works off mains, battery and gas
- a full-size kitchen sink
- more than average counter space

Another distinctive feature is the middle support bar for the sliding canopy. This not only makes the roof easier to slide but also stops the traditional more frail roof problems. It should be noted that the roof had new roof rollers in 2016.
